- 2. Working Waterfront Revitalization Initiative Update**

- a. The Economic Analysis project has been contracted to BST and is under way. The Dock Road Slope Stability Assessment project has been contracted to Fugro and will begin shortly. The Supplemental Seawater System project is in the RFP phase. The ETTIPP project is currently reviewing more detailed implementation proposals for a microgrid and an upgrade of the boat slip electrical pedestal infrastructure. The Port is awaiting a response to the MARAD/PIDP proposal and hopes to receive notification this month. The Port is also applying for the BUILD opportunity to fund the Seafood Hub and other port infrastructure. The committee will hold at least three seasonal town hall meetings, with the first scheduled for March 3rd at the Public Library.

- 3. Capital Development Priorities - recommendation**

- a. **Capital Development Priorities**

- i. The committee recommends that the commission update the draft Capital Development Priorities for 2026 to include dock piles, stormwater system upgrades, maintenance dredging, and ice production infrastructure along with the existing priorities.

- b. **Natural Hazard Mitigation Infrastructure Priorities – previously adopted by Resolution 2022-05**

- i. The committee discussed prioritizing the dock piles project, the tsunami evacuation project, and adding maintenance dredging to the Natural Hazard Mitigation Priorities, with the County.

- 4. Seawater System RFP Review - Recommendation**

- a. No additional recommendation was made to the commission, but discussions with Business Oregon clarified the necessity of proceeding with the publication of the RFP, with revisions.
